USF Dual Enrollment

- 9th – 12th grade
- 6 credits first semester
- Up to 11 credits thereafter
- Qualifying testing options
IE: Accuplacer, PERT, etc.
- 3.5 + GPA
- Maintain 2.0 GPA
- Part-time **Non-Degree seeking** student



SAT: 560 Critical Reading / 530 Math



ACT: 21 Reading / 21 Mathematics



PERT: 114 Math / 106 Reading / 103 Writing
Offered at State Colleges

16 Quantitative (Q-math)



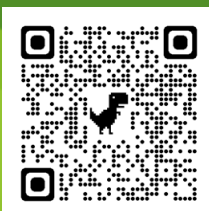
CPT (Accuplacer): 256 Reading / 253 Writing / 250 AAF (advanced algebraic functions)

USF Fall Semester (August Start)	USF Spring Semester (January Start)
On or before May 15 – Articulation agreements with school/district for Fall and Spring are due	On or before November 1 – Articulation agreements with school/district for just spring are due
On or before June 1 – Online “Non-Degree” Dual Enrollment Application for Fall Start (August) and Spring Start (January), And Counselors/ Parents/ Students/ Administrators submit FORM 1 for each student annually.	On or before November 15 – Online “Non-Degree” Dual Enrollment Application for Spring Start (January). And Counselors/ Parents/ Students/ Administrators submit FORM 1 for “New Students.”
On or before June 15 – Dual Enrollment Approval FORM 2 for Fall (August) NOTE: You may submit Spring Approval FORM 2 if known at this time for planning purposes. Use a second digital approval form noting Spring Semester.	On or before November 15 – for High School Campus Courses Approval FORM 2. November 15 – Dual Enrollment Approval Forms Due for Spring (January) for Online or USF Campus Courses.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS: When attending any USF courses FACE-TO-FACE, all students must meet IMMUNIZATION requirements including students attending on a high school campus.
